



Mushroom Compost

Mushroom compost is a high quality organic amendment that has been successfully used by professionals in the Green Industry for many years. Landscapers, gardeners and homeowners alike have found this product to aid in the rapid establishment of new plantings, and to promote healthy, vigorous growth in existing plantings.

Practical uses of mushroom compost include:

- As a soil amendment to new or existing planting beds, landscape or garden
- As a mulch to new or existing planting beds, landscape or garden
- As seeding grass and laying sod

The benefits of mushroom compost include:

1. It is a very clean material, free of weed seeds.
2. It is very nutritional – nitrogen is released as further composting takes place.
3. Particle size is favorable for the improvement of the physical properties of existing soil.
4. When used properly as a soil amendment, additional fertilizer application is not necessary.
5. New plants will establish themselves faster and more vigorously.

This compost has traditionally come from mushroom farms, and is made up of horse manure, straw, peat moss and fertilizers. Since it has been steam sterilized for mushroom growing, it is very clean. Soluble nitrogen is low, which means no burn, and as further decomposition takes place, additional nitrogen will be released. Phosphate, potassium, calcium and magnesium are quite high, but salinity is lower than typical manure. The microelement content is good for copper, high for zinc, manganese and iron and slightly low for boron. Organic content is 66% by weight.

Mushroom compost continues to be a flexible, beneficial and high quality product that has proven its usefulness over and over again.
